Process:

- 2. The LCA Board will review your application at the next Board meeting. We may come back and ask you questions prior to the Board meeting so that the Specialty Coordinator, Alexia Rodriguez, may present your application to the Board. Once discussed amongst the Board we will likely table the vote if we need more information or vote on whether or not to approve the event. You will be notified within 24 hours of the Board meeting.
- 3. If Event is approved, Alexia will guide you on how to fill out event applications for AKC and give you the specialty checklist which details what needs to be done. However, there are some different things needed for each club so the its up to you to make sure you have everything in order.
