

The Lakeland Winter Haven Kennel Club, Inc. has arranged for a **Grooming Building** to be available **Wednesday at 8:00 A.M. for Reserved Grooming and 12:00 Noon for all other exhibitors.** Free grooming available under the tent. Dogs must be **removed** from the event site immediately following shows. **No dogs may be left overnight in any building for any reason.**

Parents or guardians will be held strictly responsible for the conduct & whereabouts of their children at all times. **No strollers.**

Crates at ringside will be permitted but **must** be removed immediately following judging. Crates must have tags with Name & Telephone Number of the Owners in full view or will be removed from area.

Please help keep your area clean. Exhibitors & agents shall be responsible for the cleanliness of their area. Violators will be subject to Event Committee Hearing action.

Please clean up the grounds after exercising your dogs. Ex-pens are available as well as bags and tools for clean up. You are responsible for your dogs mess, so please clean up after them.

POLK COUNTY REQUIRES THAT ALL DOGS BROUGHT INTO THE COUNTY MUST HAVE A CURRENT RABIES CERTIFICATE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION UPON REQUEST!

State Law reference— Care and control of animals, F.S. Ch. 828; dangerous dogs, F.S. § 767.10 et seq. Sec. 14-31. - Adoption of county ordinance; certification to board of county commissioners. Section 11. Dog creating nuisance.

(a) Any owner or custodian of any dog or cat which:

(1) Habitually barks, whines, howls, cries, screams or causes other objectionable noises resulting in an unreasonable annoyance to a neighboring resident; or

(2) Disturbs the peace by habitually or repeatedly destroying or soiling public or private property, or causing injury or threatening to cause injury to any person or domestic animal on property other than that of the owner or custodian, or other similar conduct or behavior; shall be deemed to be maintaining a nuisance and in violation of this ordinance. A barking nuisance is as described in the policies and procedures for animal control complaints.

Any person who leaves a hotel room in disrepair shall be brought before the Event Committee to answer charges. Please remember: As customers of area motels, your responsible conduct ensures continued community support of dog related activities.

Exercise areas will be clearly marked. Please clean up after your dogs.

Soft sided crates are NOT permitted.

No golf carts in building. There will be designated parking for Golf Carts at Hangers.

No selling of puppies on event grounds.

- It is recommended that you bring at least 100 ft. of heavy gauge electrical cord & 100 ft. water hose to ensure capability of reaching all hook-ups. Recommend 50 ft. Of septic hose and a "Y" adapter for water hook-ups.
- Only one additional vehicle will be allowed per site.
- Any vehicles blocking roads, unoccupied RV sites, or entrances/exits of buildings will be towed at the owner's expense.
- Shower houses and port-a-lets are available on site.



An AKC Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. **(There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)**

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline (877) 252-3229.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. **An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be charged or withheld from refunds for duplicate entries.**

An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-Giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
